Pet owners have come to expect a greater quality and level of health care for their beloved companions. If you have ever thought about working with animals in a rewarding career, then becoming a member of the veterinary office team could be the path for you! With rising animal populations and a wide variety of health care services available, there is no shortage of jobs in this field.

The Career

Veterinary assistants perform a variety of tasks, depending on the type and size of the facility that employs them. They tend to the basic needs of the animal patients—health, safety, and nutrition—as well as assist veterinary technicians and veterinarians in the administration of care. Veterinary assistants may also be responsible for maintaining clean office spaces, examination and operating rooms, or animal holding areas; sterilizing equipment and instruments; preparing lab samples under supervision; and performing clerical, administrative, and reception duties.

Job Opportunities

Veterinary assistants may work on a veterinary team in laboratories, research facilities, animal hospitals, and clinics. Clinics encompass general practices as well as specialty practices, including internal medicine, surgery, dermatology and dentistry.

Employment Outlook

The employment outlook for veterinary assistants is better than the average for all occupations; the projected job growth in this field is expected to be 10% or higher by 2022 (*Bureau of Labor Statistics 2014-15, Occupational Handbook*). Job seekers who are qualified through their training should have little trouble finding employment.



What You Can Earn

Many factors are considered when calculating salary for veterinary assistants such as location, type of facility, education level and years of experience. According to the Bureau of Labor Statistics, the median wage for Veterinary Assistants was \$23,130(or \$11.12 per hour) in 2014.

Program Information

Admission Requirements

Blackstone Career Institute requires a High School or General Equivalency Diploma. Prospective students must also complete the Online Reading Assessment with a grade of 70% or higher.

Prospective students are advised that animal care facilities may have individual requirements for employment, including medical clearances, such as a rabies vaccination.

All applicants must complete and return the Enrollment Agreement along with the required down payment, or enroll online at www.blackstone.edu. Applications will be processed only if accompanied by the required payment.

Tuition

The tuition at Blackstone Career Institute is a set fee that covers the entire program described within this publication. The tuition fee can be found on the Enrollment Agreement and includes all textbooks, study guides, access to the Online Student Center, and exam evaluation services, along with your certificate and transcript upon completion.

Credit for Previous Education

Tuition reduction will be considered for equivalent college coursework earning a B or better completed within two years preceding entrance into Blackstone Career Institute. Determination of credit will be made by Blackstone's Education Department upon receipt and evaluation of an official school transcript and course description prior to enrollment. The amount of financial credit will be determined by program selection. Students are still required to complete all academic exams and assignments, regardless of approved credits.

Transfer of Credit

Credit transferability is at the discretion of the receiving university or college.

Duration

Blackstone allows up to one year to complete this career program. An extension may be granted if requested in writing.



Examinations and Grading

After reading each study unit, students will then complete the required examination through our Online Student Center at www. blackstone.edu. Students receive instant feedback after submitting their exams, including page references for incorrect answers.

Graduation Requirements and Completion Documents

In order to earn a certificate, a student must achieve a minimum average of 70 percent in the program. Upon successful completion of the program, the student is awarded a transcript and certificate.

A certificate and an official transcript of record are furnished to the student at the conclusion of the course without charge. For additional copies, a nominal fee is charged. Students may print an unofficial transcript from the Online Student Center at any time.

Course Interruption

Leaves of absence for a maximum of three months will be granted for good cause. A request should be made in writing to the Student Services Department. A leave of absence does not extend the required time for completion.



Student Tuition Protection Policy

Blackstone Career Institute is confident that the course you have selected will be everything we advertise. To assure you of this, we provide this cancellation and refund policy. A student may cancel the program by notifying the school in any manner; a written request is recommended. If you cancel within 5 days from the signature date on your Enrollment Agreement, all monies will be refunded. If you cancel after 5 days from the signature date of your Enrollment Agreement, but prior to receipt by the school of your first exam, you are obligated to a registration fee of 15% of the tuition or \$150, whichever is less, and if applicable, the non-refundable administrative fee. If you cancel after submitting the first exam, you are obligated to pay the school the registration fee, the non-refundable administrative fee, plus a percentage of tuition as follows:

- A. Up to and including 10% of the exams, 10% of the tuition.
- B. After submitting more than 10% up to and including 25% of the exams, 25% of the tuition.
- C. After submitting more than 25% up to and including 50% of the exams, 50% of the tuition.
- D. After submitting more than 50% of the exams, you owe the school the full tuition.

If you choose to cancel and have paid the school more than the amount as calculated above, all excess payments will be refunded. Students who wish to cancel their enrollment with Blackstone and have a balance due, will have their terms payment processed through their existing credit card or echeck account. A reinstatement fee of \$35.00 will be required for the reactivation of any enrollment if requested within 180 days from initial cancellation. Refunds are processed within 30 days to the payee of record. No refunds will be issued after 12 months from the enrollment date.
